5. ONGOING ISSUES

Colton Lane Junction The Clerk has replied to CYC supporting their proposed scheme, but stating that we are still concerned with the poor sight lines for vehicles leaving Colton Lane. There will be clearer and earlier signage, and anti-skid surfacing and red road markings.

Main Street Lighting As agreed at the last Parish Council meeting there will be an Open Meeting in September to discuss how to spend the £4,000 which we have for street lighting. It has already been agreed to leave the Conservation Area as it is, with lights being replaced on a like for like basis as and when they fail. Cllr Bowen has made enquiries about the possible removal of telegraph poles and associated overhead cables in the Conservation Area.

Traffic Noise from the A64 Cllrs Stericker, Bowen and Mrs Stones had attended a meeting with John Grogan, MP and representatives of CYC Highways Department. Resurfacing would mitigate the noise problem, but this is unlikely to happen for a further 10-15 years. There is no case for extending the fence, which was never designed as a sound barrier.

Burial Ground Parking The Clerk has asked CYC to carry out site investigations and come up with a design.

Allotment Gate A quote of £1,490 has been received for creating a 15m hardcore path, fenced either side, and removing the gate in from the boundary hedge. The Clerk to ask allotment holders if they would be prepared to pay 50% of the cost, and to seek further quotes.

Shopping Centre Car Park

Cllr Bowen is speaking to CYC following their response to our letter. A letter is received from Mrs Spence asking if we are making any progress. Cllr Bowen to draft a reply.
