7. RURAL WEST YORK

Cllr Carr had attended the Ward Team Meeting, where the police had reported on a suspicion of drug use on the section of Yorkfield Lane between Low Green and Merchant Way. The Copmanthorpe Volunteers have been asked to cut back the undergrowth in this area.

8. NEIGHBOURHOOD PLAN

The Plan has been submitted to CYC. There is a question mark over the need for a Strategic Environmental Appraisal on the Tadcaster Road site insofar as it may affect the 'historic character and setting of the City of York'.

9. DRAFT LOCAL PLAN

It is clear that there will be no progress on this until after the elections on 7 May. In recent weeks the Durham City Draft Local Plan has been rejected by DCLG. The proposed development site at Brecks Lane in Strensall which was going to be approved by CYC was called in by the DCLG and turned down. Furthermore, the Office for National Statistics has produced some figures which show a far lesser number of houses required in York.

10. HEDGE AT BURIAL GROUND

It has been suggested by the Trust for Conservation Volunteers that the hedge which forms the rear boundary of the burial ground would greatly benefit from being laid. Councillors are happy to accept this advice, and the Clerk will try to ascertain what the cost will be and what grants, if any, for this work may be available.
