Before the business of the Meeting began, members of the public present raised some matters of concern to them.

The speed bumps outside the doctors need modifying as vehicles are being driven over them at too high a speed, causing nearby houses to vibrate.

Parking in the bay at the rear of the Co-op store where vehicles park diagonally which results in the rear sticking out onto Church Lane. This causes problems and hazards for passing vehicles and pedestrians alike. It was suggested that the pavement be widened to its full width, giving easier passage for pedestrians, buggies and mobility scooters etc.

The street lighting between Wheelwright Close and the tennis courts is very poor, which was highlighted on Saturday night as people walked to and from the Christmas Event.

Sawyers Crescent was yet again flooded with raw sewage during the recent heavy rains.

CYC has been informed as it is responsible for replacing the official speed limit signs. The Christmas tree at the top of Manor Heath had also been removed and dumped but will be retrieved from the embankment by Copmanthorpe Volunteers. Councillors were angered and appalled at the planned vandalism. This has been reported to the police.
