#### 11. YORKFIELD LANE and BECKETT'S CROSSING

The Parish Council will continue to object to Network Rail's current proposal for this crossing, and will press for a temporary halt to the progress of the planning submission.

In light of the difficulty in persuading CYC to carry out a full survey of Yorkfield Lane, a quote of £1,250 plus VAT has been obtained for a full topographical survey to be carried out, which could be used for enforcement of the statutory width of the Lane.

## 14. HOWELL HALL and YOUTH CLUB

A new Youth Leader has been appointed, and the number of attendees has increased by 50-60%. There has been a commensurate increase in income from the tuck shop, and generally things are going well. Monies are being put aside for maintenance of the Hall, and the installation of solar panels is being actively considered.

## 15. EVENTS

Planning for the Christmas event, to be held on 3<sup>rd</sup> December, is underway. A budget of £3,000 has been set aside.

#### 17. BURIAL GROUND

It seems unlikely that Sheppard Construction will agree to sell land for the Parish Council to extend the existing burial ground. There are other possible options on sites coming up for development which could be considered.

The newly refurbished gates are now in situ, but there is some damage to one of the stone posts. The Clerk is in contact with a local builder with a view to getting this repaired.
